Reciprocal Use Agreement

Purpose

The purpose of this agreement is to establish an understanding between the Central Jersey Radio Group (CJRG) and the General Mobile Radio Service (GMRS) system named below regarding the sharing of services between the two.

Authorization

Any member or authorized user of the CJRG may use the radio system named in this agreement without any additional prior permission, and vice versa, provided that the following is true:

1. The user is currently authorized by the system owner to use his or her repeater(s) without special restrictions;
2. The user holds a valid GMRS license;
3. The user abides by all GMRS rules, regulations, and guidelines in effect by both the FCC and the repeater owner, especially those about station identification and monitor-before-transmit;
4. The user is aware and considerate of the shared nature of the repeaters;
5. The user has not had access privileges revoked by either repeater owner.

CJRG Affiliation

While this agreement is in effect, CJRG may at its sole discretion decide to list the radio system named in this agreement as an affiliate on its website and any other website or medium in which CJRG represents itself. The owner of the radio system may likewise list CJRG repeaters as affiliated systems on its website and other media while this agreement is in effect. Upon termination of the agreement, each party must remove the references to the other affiliated systems immediately and without hesitation.

Authorized User Lists

In order for the representatives of either system to be aware of who is properly authorized on an affiliated system, a method in which a list of currently authorized users may be shared between system owners needs to be established. Each system owner has the responsibility to make a list of their authorized users (including banned users) available on a monthly basis or upon request. This step will prevent unnecessary interrogation of legitimate users on the air by the system owners.
